

Notice from Fukuoka City

Regarding the Novel Coronavirus

Cases of the novel coronavirus have been confirmed in Fukuoka City.

Take care with the following points.

- If you have the following symptoms call the multilingual hotline for non-Japanese speakers:
 - A cough or a fever of 37.5°C or more for more over 4 days
 - If you feel very tired or breathless

You may be told to visit a hospital. Wear a mask when going to the hospital, and do not use public transport such as trains or buses.

- Preventing the spread of the Novel Coronavirus:
 - Do not go to school or work if you have a fever
 - Wash your hands when you get home after going outside
 - Gargle when you get home after going outside
 - Clean your hands with an alcohol-based cleanser
 - Avoid places with large crowds
 - Open your windows to let clean air in
 - Sleep well
 - Maintain a healthy and balanced diet
 - Wear a mask when sneezing or coughing
 - If you don't have a mask, cover your nose and mouth with a tissue or the crease of your elbow
