In December 2010, he felt his hands begin to shake. He collapsed at his home in Osaka after working with no sleep to finish a drawing. He had suffered a stroke. When Katsuma came to, he felt numb along the left side of his body and couldn't hold a paint brush with his dominant hand. He was 59 at the time. His doctor told him he wouldn't be able to work again as a

But Katsuma refused to give up. Thinking that he might be able to draw using a personal computer, he moved the mouse with his right hand and drew a picture. He kept at it although he wasn't satisfied with the outcome.

He posted the drawing on his Facebook page, and it instantly attracted hundreds of likes and made him feel confident in his skills. Since then, Katsuma has posted his drawings online every day.

His drawings attracted the attention of an art dealer, who helped Katsuma organize a solo exhibition at a department store in September 2017. It was his first experience showing his works in a gallery. Some visitors shed tears as they remembered their dead pets.

"I always wanted to draw pictures that would be remembered because I had drawn nothing but manga and other drawings that would be thrown away after a short while," Katsuma said.

It felt like a new path was opening up in front of him, he said.
